

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type blade carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades may differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the tine. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
