Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine store employing just four people. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and different components. Within 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 employees and their annual sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is amongst the leading worldwide producers in the material handling trade.

Design and production of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively engage in new business possibilities. All through the last sixty years, the trade of material handling has grown into a really advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best supplier of forklift accessories and various associated items. The company feels confident in their potential to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, making and advertising hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was completed in 1956 on a brand new office to be able to house all of the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total staff reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

A second production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The company altered its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The company has expanded its production facilities within the U.S. with areas in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade merchandise are fabricated worldwide thanks to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is designed to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 after acquiring five corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international leader in blades.
